SOUND BEGINNINGS ADVISORY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

Early detection and assessment of hearing loss are the keys to successful habilitation of infants and toddlers. With universal newborn hearing screening mandated in Kansas since July 1999, all infants are required to have their hearing screened before one month of age, if parent has consented. It is preferable for the screening to be completed prior to discharge from the birthing facility but no longer than 5 days unless medically contraindicated. It is expected that those infants who Fail the hearing screen will receive a diagnostic audiological evaluation performed by a Pediatric Audiologist
