South Dakota Early Hearing Detection & Intervention

Hearing loss in children is more common than you think!

- When a hearing loss is identified early, a child can begin receiving intervention and experience better outcomes.
- Hearing screens can be done if a caregiver has concern about the child's hearing or the child has risk factors for hearing loss.
- There are many types of hearing loss, from mild hearing loss to complete loss of hearing, in one ear or both ears.

Signs of Hearing Loss

- Limited, poor, or no speech
- Frequently distracted
- Difficulty learning
- Fails to respond to their name
- Easily frustrated when there is
 a lot of background noise

Risk Factors for Hearing Loss

- Note: Many children have NO risk factors
- Has a family history of childhood hearing loss
- Stayed in the NICU
- Had infections such as meningitis or cytomegalovirus
- Was given medications that can lead to hearing loss
 (Joint Committee on Infant Hearing)
