Outpatient Hearing Screen

If your baby has a **HEARING LOSS**:

- ✓ Contact State Newborn Hearing Screening Program
- ✓ Contact Step*Hi Early Intervention Program
- ✓ Contact NM Hands and Voices
- ✓ Learn about communication options and programs
- ✓ Discuss use of Hearing Aids and availability of loaner hearing aids with audiologist
- ✓ Learn about FM systems, Cochlear Implants, etc.

Audiological Evaluation completed by well baby check at 3 months old

Before 6 Months

Baby has a HEARING LOSS:

Enroll in Step*Hi early intervention program for children birth to age six who are deaf or hard of hearing (*Children who participate in early intervention prior to six months can have age appropriate skills by preschool*)

See **Ear, Nose and Throat (ENT)** doctor for medical clearance for hearing aids

See **Pediatric Audiologist** as recommended

Evaluations to discuss with your child's doctor:

Ophthalmologist (Eye Specialist)

Genetic Specialist

Other Medical Specialists (heart, kidneys, development, etc)
